How to Apply

Your application should include:

- Completed online application form, including personal statement
- Transcripts and public examination result certificates (e.g. SAT score report, etc.)
- School reports from grade 10 onwards
- Certificates and proof for significant prizes and/or awards
- Proof of English Language proficiency (e.g. IELTS, TOEFL, etc.)
- Copy of national ID card or travel document
- Academic reference
- Predicted grade report (if available)
- Application Fee of HKD450 (~USD58)



Advanced Credit

Students holding certain qualifications, such as IB Diploma and GCEAL/IAL, may be eligible for advanced credits granted at entry. On average, students with international qualifications can get 16 advanced credits. For more details, please refer to arr.ust.hk/ust_actoe.

Scholarships

Non-local students refer to individuals requiring a student visa or an entry permit to study in Hong Kong.

* Non-local students are guaranteed university-provided accommodation for the first 2 years of study while local students are guaranteed 1-term hall residence in their first year of study. Students may need to arrange for their own accommodation thereafter. On average, off-campus rental cost is HKD5,000 per month, excluding bills and utilities.

[^] The final year of the Dual Degree Program in Technology and Management is offered on a self-financing basis. For reference: the tuition is HKD60,000 p.a. for local students and HKD120,000 p.a. for non-local students in 2015-2016.
